Gap Identification	<p>For the previous Church Years, JPRC has been mandated to organize forums for the Young Peoples in the aim of bringing them together and getting facilitators to engage them on various topics.</p> <p>While these forums have been largely successful the Group felt that the impact is not being felt as intended.</p>
Proposed Innovation	<p>We strategized on how we can be innovative on this crucial activity and decided to organize the forums for targeted professional groups.</p>
Detailed expected Result/Impact to the Church	<p>In this innovation, we intend to create real impact by bringing various Young Peoples in their specific profession's together and mentor them by linking them up to the senior members in their profession.</p> <p>This in the long run will see the Church attract even young people outside the PCEA church and they will eventually join the Young People's Service.</p>
Implementation Strategy	<p>The implementation strategy will involve organizing periodic forums and breakfast with young people in specific profession.</p>
