Monday 10/01/2022	<p>ADORATION</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take a moment to adore God. • Worship the Lord with hymns and songs (How great thou art, great is thy faithfulness) <p>And one called out to another and said, “Holy, Holy, Holy, is the Lord of hosts, The whole earth is full of His glory.” (Isaiah 6:3)</p>
Tuesday 11/01/2022	<p>CONFESSION AND REPENTANCE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Confess/repent for the below sins/iniquities as below; • As believers, we identify all those areas that needs repentance and take them before God such as individual sins, Family sins, national sins; bloodshed, sexual immorality, idolatry, corruption, injustice, compromise & lawlessness, unfaithfulness, selfishness, oppression, tribalism, rebellion, witchcraft, and Luke-warmness. (Matthew 4:17, Prov.28:13, Acts 8:22)
Wednesday 12/10/2022	<p>CONSECRATION (Joshua 3:1, Rom.12:1)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pray that the LORD will help us pray according to His will (<i>1 John 5:14-15</i>). • Pray that our spiritual ears and eyes will be open to what God is doing and saying to us. • Pray for a heart of humility to submit to what God might demand of us to stop, improve or start afresh (<i>James 4:7-10</i>). • Pray that as believers we shall involve our children as much as possible in this season of prayer (<i>Joel 2:15-17</i>).
Thursday 13/10/2022	<p>THANKSGIVING</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Thank God for preserving us and our families through the year 2021 with its hardships, COVID-19, floods, economic and political crises. • Thank God for the blessings of a new year 2022 (<i>Ps.100:3-5</i>) • Thanksgiving for Christ’s victory on the cross which changed the old priestly pattern to a Royal Priesthood (<i>1Peter 2:9</i>) • Thank God for the use of new media and technology to spread the gospel • Thank God for a new dispensation “new-normal” (<i>Psalms 107:8-9</i>)
